8550 RESEARCH

The Board sees a need from time to time to cooperate with individuals and agencies wishing to conduct research in the system insofar as the proposed research is likely to result in improved services to students without detracting from the primary mission of the school. The Superintendent shall review requests from individuals and/or agencies for any research project.

8550.1 The Superintendent may plan new programs on a short-term, pilot basis, if it appears that the program being developed can be of basic and intrinsic value to the students and shows promise of being transferable.

8550.2 The Superintendent shall develop guidelines that balance the educational value of research against students' privacy rights (see Policy 6830 – Surveys and Interviews with Students), and outline the basis for decisions approving such educational research.
