Preschool Enrollment

Classes include a blended group of children ages three through five including typically developing children who pay tuition to attend, children who qualify for exceptional education services and children in the NC Pre-Kindergarten Program.

 All children must be three to five years of age, not eligible for kindergarten and a resident of Moore County.

Exceptional Children

The IEP Team determines eligibility and educational placement for students with disabilities according to North Carolina's Policies Governing Services for Children with Disabilities. Tuition

Children in a tuition slot must pass a developmental screening prior to enrollment. They may not be eligible for exceptional children services. Annual registration and weekly fees apply.

- To place your child on the waiting list, contact the administrative assistant in Exceptional Children Services at 910-947-2342. Students may be placed on the list at birth.
- Priority is given to children of Moore County Schools Employees.
- Enrollment begins in March for the upcoming school year.
- Slots are filled as openings occur.

North Carolina Pre-Kindergarten (NCPK)

The Division of Child Development and Early Education determines eligibility and priority for at-risk children to attend the NCPK program. Students must be below 75% of the state median income and turn 4 by August 31st of the school year. The Moore County NC Pre-Kindergarten Committee selects students from applicants submitted according to state guidelines.

Although applications are accepted on an on-going basis, the initial selection of students is made from those submitted by March 31st. Applications will be taken at the following locations: Carthage Elementary-March 19; Robbins Elementary-March 11; Vass-Lakeview Elementary-March 4; West End Elementary-March 26; Southern Pines Primary-March 24; and Aberdeen Primary-March 17.
