To: Parents/Guardians of Students at Moore County School District

A Federal funding opportunity called **Impact Aid** will be distributed **Tomorrow, October 25th** to all schools.

Impact Aid is designed to assist local school districts that have lost tax revenue due to the presence of tax-exempt federal property, or experienced increased expenditures due to the enrollment of federally connected children.

Eligibility for funding is determined each school year through the Federal Impact Aid Survey Form. Additionally, MCS has combined the Impact Aid Survey with the Every Student Succeeds Act Military Student Identifier Form. The district is asking all federally connected families, regardless of their status, to participate in the October survey eliminating the need for a second survey.

To qualify for Impact Aid funding, we must have a completed form for each federally connected student. All eligible families are asked to complete either an electronic survey OR paper survey. Please do not submit both.

- Electronic Surveys These will automatically be available on your child's Powerschool Account
 on 10/25 under Forms. If you have multiple children in Moore County Schools, you can select
 "Submit For Entire Family" when using the electronic survey.
- Paper Surveys These will be sent home on 10/25 from your school. If you have more than one
 child in Moore County Schools, you must complete a paper survey for EVERY child in your
 household.

Please complete the electronic OR paper survey no later than Friday, November 17, 2023.
